1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Access to
3	Quality Sober Living Act of 2017".
4	SEC. 2. BEST PRACTICES FOR OPERATING RECOVERY
5	HOUSING.
6	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Health and
7	Human Services, acting through the Director of the Cen-
8	ter for Substance Abuse Treatment of the Substance
9	Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration—
10	(1) shall publish best practices for operating re-
11	covery housing, based on—
12	(A) the applicable domains, core principles,
