1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled
3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4 This Act may be cited as the "Saving All Flyers from
5 Ejection and Securing Everyone's Access to Travel Act
6 or the "SAFE SEAT Act".
7 SEC. 2. AIR TRAVEL IMPROVEMENTS.
8 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Transportation
9 shall issue or revise regulations to ensure that—

1	(1) a passenger, after boarding an aircraft for
2	a flight, is not subjected to the use of force or invol-
3	untary removal unless directly necessary for safety
4	or security;
5	(2) air carriers resolve all issues relating to
6	overbooking of a flight prior to beginning boarding
7	for that flight; and
8	(3) air carriers, before an individual is denied
9	boarding involuntarily with respect to a flight, make
10	a compensation offer—
11	(A) to any individual willing to voluntarily
12	forgo boarding for that flight; and
13	(B) in an amount that is at least the max-
14	imum compensation amount required under
15	Federal regulations for passengers denied
16	boarding involuntarily.
17	(b) AIR CARRIER DEFINED.—In this section, the
18	term "air carrier" has the meaning given that term in sec-
19	tion 40102(a) of title 49, United States Code.
