Dear Secretary Mayorkas:

We write to express our support for the immediate closure of the Adelanto ICE Processing Center and urge the Department of Homeland Security to take immediate steps to terminate the contract. Earlier this month, Fox News reported<sup>1</sup> that the nearly 2,000 bed-capacity Adelanto Center is on the verge of closing. Adelanto's deplorable conditions have been widely reported and the GEO Group, which runs the facility, has long been responsible for violating the constitutional rights of the people in its custody.

GEO has a long, deadly track record of delaying or denying necessary medical and mental health treatment to immigrants detained at Adelanto. Eight individuals have died as a result, and ICE's own investigation deemed each death preventable.<sup>2</sup> As Members of Congress, we have been sounding the alarm for nearly a decade about the risks Adelanto poses Following a 2015 letter<sup>3</sup> from NGOs in Southern California detailing poor conditions at the facility, we wrote expressed concerns to the Department of Homeland Security regarding<sup>4</sup> the issues at Adelanto and urging

its immediate closure.<sup>5</sup> Matters have not improved: a recent NPR report<sup>6</sup> detailed extensive records of abuse and horrendous conditions across the nation, including at Adelanto. GEO's failure to provide appropriate care at Adelanto and other facilities make clear that it is incapable of ensuring the health and safety of individuals detained.

State<sup>7</sup> and federal oversight agencies<sup>8</sup> that have inspected Adelanto have identified the same problems, naming serious deficiencies in physical and mental healthcare in particular. Despite these agencies' concerns and recommendations, the same issues have persisted for nearly a decade. GEO's negligent, unconstitutional conduct at the facility has caused ICE to pay judgments and fee awards with taxpayer dollars. These cases also highlight the human cost of immigration detention.

The underlying humanitarian concerns associated with detention facilities—especially those with such a low occupancy rate—show that keeping Adelanto open is both harmful and unnecessary. The mental and physical well-being of those within the facility must be a priority, and a cost-benefit analysis of keeping the center open under such circumstances weighs heavily against its continued operation.
